Madame, Monsieur,

1. The NATO Maintenance and Supply Agency (NAMSA) has been designated by the NATO Infrastructure Committee as Host Nation for the implementation of ISAF OPS004a Phase II Serial 2008/5VA30467-0, titled "CIVIL WORKS FOR REPLACING AND UPGRADING OF TWO (2) ENTRY CONTROL POINTS (ECP) AT ISAF HQ IN KABUL, AFGHANISTAN".
2. The International Competitive Bidding (ICB) will be conducted in accordance with Reference 1, which stipulates that NAMSA, at the earliest possible moment, even before the request for authorization to commit funds is submitted, issues a NOI to Invite Bids to the diplomatic representative(s) of the participating countries in the capital of the country where NAMSA is situated.
3. This letter constitutes the NOI to Invite Bids for the project mentioned at paragraph 1 above and as further described in Annex A.

4. NAMSA as host nation for the above mentioned project hereby invites you to:
 - 4.1. nominate firms located in your nation which may wish to participate in the ICB;
 - 4.2. provide for each nominated firm a "Declaration of Eligibility" in the format provided at Annex B.
5. You are kindly requested to provide either individually or - preferably - collectively the "Declaration of Eligibility" for the companies from your nation which you wish NAMSA to invite to tender. The requested information should be addressed to:



and should reach NAMSA not later than **26 February 2010**.

According to Reference 1, Annex 2, Paragraph 6.1.1. an Invitation For Bids can not be issued to any company, until a Declaration of Eligibility is received by the Host Nation from the Government of the potential bidder's country. For companies already identified on the NAMSA source list national authorities still have to issue a Declaration of Eligibility before an award of contract could be made to such a firm.
