1. GENERAL

a. This document is a Call for an international Bid for the study preparation under the title: «STUDY FOR THE DESIGN, MANUFACTURING, INSTALLATION AND FOLLOW ON SUPPORT OF A MULTIPLE MISSILE TRACKING RADAR (MMTR)» (M/K-442N), that will be implemented in Greece (Site Klapes, NAMFI, Crete Island).

b. This study preparation is a NATO common funded project, under the Serial 2001/5SA06070-0 according to the Infrastructure Committee decision AC/4-DS(2009)0002 (INV), item 5.1.6.

c. This document is distributed to the NATO permanent Delegations in Brussels, the respective Embassies of the 25 NATO member countries in Greece, who are financing the subject study, as well the NATO International Staff in Brussels. The Nations are kindly requested to inform their country's Engineering (A/E) firms for the subject bid and submit the appropriate Declaration of Eligibility for their interested firms [cf. para. 5.(ii).(a) of AC/4-D/2261 - 1996 Edition] to the address:

d. Hellenic A/E firms interested to participate in the subject bid, shall submit a formal request to the address of the above para.1.c, not later than the date of para. 8.a, including a certification copy of their registration to the Hellenic A/E record members or companies, as well as a certificate that they are registered in the Hellenic Ministry of Defence (HNDGS) records, certifying that they are eligible to participate in NATO Secret bid studies.

e. The eligible A/E firms according to para. 2.a bellow, will receive an invitation to bid, while the detailed information for the bidding process will be distributed through the «*Cahier des Charges*».

f. The international bid will be executed according to the International direction AC/4-D/2261-(1996 Edition) and the selection of the contractor shall take place according to the procedure specified in L.3316/2005 (para. 4 of article 7) where a cost-effective principle is followed.

2. PARTICIPATION of BIDDERS

a. A/E firms that may participate in the bidding, according to article 2, para. 2 in combination with article 7, para. 2.c as specified in law 3316/2005, are those carrying the respective certificate of convenience, recorded in the Hellenic records of A/E firms, as described in article 39 of law 3316/2005, in the E' level of the category for "Electrical, Mechanical and Electronic" studies.

b. All A/E firms may participate in the subject bid independently, in joint ventures or consortiums which have been or shall be established, as long as they are or their members are (concerning joint ventures or consortiums) :

(1) Registered in the Hellenic records of A/E firms and offices, carrying the appropriate certificates specified in para. 2.a above and also registered in the special NATO catalogues of the Hellenic Ministry of Defense, according to which they are allowed to participate in NATO projects up to NATO SECRET, as specified in article 12 of P.D. 378/87

or

(2) A/E firms of the twenty five (25) NATO members who are financing the subject study preparation, as follows : Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Germany, (Greece), Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Turkey, United Kingdom and United States of America, which maintain respective records for A/E firms, are registered in these records carrying the respective certificates specified in para. 2.a above, are specialized in similar to the above subject study preparation, and are nominated by their local authorities as eligible to participate to the subject bid, according to para. 5.(ii).(a) of NATO AC/4-D/2261 (1996 Edition) by a "DECLARATION OF ELIGIBILITY"

or

(3) A/E firms of the twenty five (25) NATO members of the above para. 2.b.(2), which do not maintain respective records for A/E firms specified in para. 2.a above, are registered in Professional / Commercial registers or respective ones of their country, are specialized in similar to the above subject study preparation, they have adequate experience respective to the applied in the A/E firms specified in para. 2.a above, where their engineering staff is obliged to have equivalent experience specified in article 39 of L.3316/2005 for study category 9 (Mechanical, electrical and electronic) consisting at least of 2 staff engineers of 12 years experience and one staff engineer of 8 years experience and 4 staff engineers of 4 years experience in the category, and they are nominated by their local authorities as eligible to participate to the subject bid, according to para. 5.(ii).(a) of NATO AC/4-D/2261 (1996 Edition) by a "DECLARATION OF ELIGIBILITY"

c. The bidders who are in compliance with the terms specified in para. 2.a and 2.b are also obliged to meet additional technical and professional capabilities certified as follows:

(1) Already implemented similar to the above mentioned studies, by the respective A/E firm, during the last 15 years at least in one NATO country.

By the term "similar studies" the following categories apply:

- Design, construction and installation of a radar tracking system and its remote control
- Communication network systems and radar voice & data exchange
- Logistic support

The above will be established by providing respective prototype governmental certificates, which will be filed along with all other supporting documents required by the bidding terms by the bid closing date. In case that one of the bidders shall fail to provide the above mentioned prototype governmental certificates its bid will be disqualified for not complying.

(2) Supported by specialised staff which shall be added in the study team during the technical proposal preparation, consisting of at least one engineer with the appropriate degree or respective diploma as well as a valid license to practice, in its resident country or abroad and having the appropriate experience specified above.

d. Each A/E firm is allowed to participate in the bid independently or as a member in only one joint venture or consortium according the equal treatment principle as specified in article 4 of the NATO direction AC/4-D2261 (1996 edition)

e. A/E Firms deriving from countries other than NATO countries or from NATO countries which do not finance the subject project, are not allowed to participate in the subject bid having been contracted as contractors or subcontractors as a result of the present contract or prepare any part of the study.

f. A/E firms not approved to participate in the subject bid, by the appropriate local authority or who do not comply with at least one of the conditions specified in the above articles 2.a and 2.b are not allowed to participate in the subject bid, in any form (independently, as members of a joint venture or a consortium).

g. The structure of any form of consortium or joint venture shall be demonstrated by relevant actions, to be submitted on the bid closing date. If such actions are not submitted, the offer shall be considered as non-compliant. In any form of consortium or joint venture there shall be an appointed representative, who will represent all consortia members to HAFGS.

3. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT

The scope of this Contract is the design, of a new Multi Missile Tracking Radar, in relation to the subject project, which is described in the Technical Description and other bidding documents, which outline the contractors' responsibilities.

4. COST ESTIMATE

The project's cost is estimated to eight hundred thousand (800.000,00) EUROS.

5. ESTIMATED TIME OF COMPLETION OF STUDY PREPARATION

The the study preparation should be completed within four and half (4,5) months from the date of the Contract signature.

6. SECURITY CLASSIFICATION

a. The study preparation is classified as «NATO RESTRICTED» and all national or NATO security regulations apply (cf. C-M (55)15-FINAL).

b. The firms shall protect all bid related documentation according to national or NATO security regulations.

7. **VALIDITY OF BIDS**

The competitors' bids will have validity of twelve (12) months.

8. **DATES**

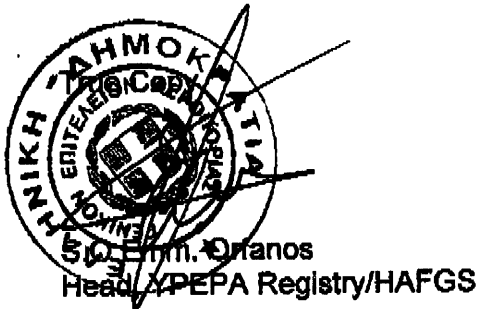
